SANDBAGS

During the winter, Vallejo Sanitation & Flood Control District supplies free sand and burlap bags to residents in the greater Vallejo area, and provides instruction in filling and stacking bags. Free sandbags are available at the District's sandbag station, located at 45 Solano Ave., west of Sonoma Blvd. The station is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The station is open mid-October through mid-April.

Follow instructions on the sign by the gate to enter. Sand and bags are free. You may wish to purchase plastic sheeting to put under the sandbags at your home. At the sandbag station, you'll find instructions on how to fill a sandbag and how to properly build a sandbag wall. For more information, call (707) 644-8949 ext. 200 during regular business hours.



After hours or on weekends, the sandbag station is opened if there is a high demand during a major storm. To find out if the sandbag station is open, you can call (707) 644-8949. The after-hours answering service will take your request and give it to an on-call staffer, who will call you back and let you know if the station is open.

This year, in expectation of a wet winter, sandbag stations will be established in these additional locations:

• Vallejo Marina: in parking lot between Marina Office and Zio Fraedo's restaurant.

Curtola Parkway: at the boat launch next to the former bait shop across from the Marina Vista Apartments;

Hiddenbrooke Park: at the end of Alder Creek Road, at the park entrance;

Fire Station #27: on Ascot Court off Columbus Parkway (across from Lowe's Home Improvement Center).


• White Slough: Head west on Yolano Drive from Sonoma Blvd., turn left on Enterprise.

PREPARE FOR THE RAINS

Start now to prepare for the winter rains and prevent flood damage during the rainy season. Here are some must do items:

- Clean out gutters and downspouts on your house and garage.
- Remove trash and leaves from street gutters to prevent clogging storm drains and flooding.
- Keep the drainage system (creeks and culverts)of your property free of debris.
- Clear dead trees, limbs and vegetation that may block a drainage system.
- For homes with basements install flood shields or barriers above the base flood elevation.
